Once he shares his ideas to his friends and thus starts a cricket shop nearby Omi's father's temple. Every evening Govind take tuition to get some penny in order to help his mother. [12] Here middle-class people and lower class peoples need is to earn money for a peaceful life. Rich people they get huge amount but don't have satisfaction and their only motive to gather more money. Ishaan is another character whose passion is watching TV and gives coaching for street players. He has a sister, waiting for entrance examand so Ishaan ask his friend Govind to teach maths for her. Govind accept the request that is the turning point of his life. Alas! He forgets Vidya is his best friend's sister and makes relationship that was his Second mistake.

This novel especially comes at a time when people want to come up with excuses to show a different aspect rather than seeing the common aspects and bring once which can keep us together and achieve our common goal of growth, peace and prosperity.[13, 14] Here Chetan's writing is good, and his language is simple, it connects well with the youth of India. In his first mistake, the protagonist loses his big dream to buy a new shopping mall in his living area unfortunately the earthquake collapsed his life & dream. These are the main issues in this chapter.

Chetan Bhagat is not just an author, but he is an icon of youngsters. Chetan has opened with the columns for leading newspaper, mirroring on youth and national growth. It denotes the day by day change in culture and tradition. They have their own right to select their way of living and this young generation people prefer to follow foreign lifestyle.

But the olden days a boy and girl were bound to marry according to the choice of their parents and were regarded as their parent's duty to repay the debt of parenthood. A great Indian writer Mulk Raj Anand's *Untouchable* describes social humiliation of Bakha who suffered because of his caste by birth. Govind is a narrator of this novel, who tells about his real-life story. How the society focuses upon the youngsters what the society expects with the youngsters are the major theme expressed by Chetan in this novel [27, 28]. Govind is genius in maths, who has the habit of helping all the little boys in his area. He was the city topper in mathematics in higher secondary exam. If he had wished to do his engineering program, he could have done it extra ordinarily. But his passion and aimlie towards business and wants to gain more money. So, he gave up his higher education program and moved his concentration towards business. [30] Bhagat has made all his characters to be the best decision makers. [31, 32] On the other hand all other contemporary writers will frame their characters, stay away from their aim by following the wish of their parents and boss.

In this novel [33] another protagonist Omi, who lives in the temple, but he fails to realize the existence of Almighty. He has never found the mental response, power and blessings in the temple. [34, 35] When he starts the business with narrator, he felt the presence of the almighty. He helps the narrator with simple works and plans about a sports shop. In free time he gives some tips to Ali how to maintain his body and health [36, 37]. He (God) lives with the person directed to serve the humanities for no personal gain. [38] Bhagat doesn't tell the God is inside of the temple, because he is living inside of the heart of the people who has serving tendency. [41, 42]Govind does not

go to the temple and never believed God, but God never hate any people. He admires the superficial strength with simplicity and devotee mind in the business. He worships him with fidelity through his friends. Omi support a Muslim boy Ali is against the wish of his parents. Omi fights against his uncle because he helps him to grown up in their business.[39, 40] Ali saves the priceless asset of the country, but Omi has to give up his life while fighting against the anti-socialist who creates problem in the name of religion and caste.

Since, the modern world youth [43, 44]are of strong outlook, practical, bold and brave enough with passion in their eyes, with the passion and dream the three friends joined together to open up a cricket shop. As they start growing in their business they decided to open up the new cricket shop in the mall, however their fate does not favour them, because the earthquake make the multi storied building crumble and it comes as serious shock to all their efforts. He is helping his widow mother [64, 65], his only aim to become a great businessman but a fate crosses his life to destroy his dream. The novel moves to the dramatic moments in the life of all the characters, namely, [46, 56] religious part. In India large number of people and religion in our country, but difference of religious brought in hatred and bitterness among the followers of different religious [74, 75].

In this novel the reader can see the complicated religious passion interwoven with the Post-Godhra Communal riots [76] in Ahmadabad. As young people Govind, Ishaan and Omi tried their best to get rid of the riot.
